

# Dice Game

## *Supplies needed:*

- Prize Basket – I use a basket of full-sized products, 5 of them around \$10-\$15 in value (lipsticks, hand & body lotions, shampoo, conditioner, body polish, etc.) and 5 of the 2oz Hand & Body Lotions (Or you could use goodie bags with a couple of samples of products in them to decrease your cost.)
- Printed cards – 5 Win a Prize, 5 Win a Party and 1 Grand Prize
- 2 dice
- 11 envelopes
- 11 blank cards (I get mine from Dollar Tree. They come in 8 Packs.)
- Ziploc bag for storing dice and cards

## *Assembly:*

- Print and cut out the 11 cards.
- On the outside of the 11 envelopes, write the numbers 2 through 12.
- Tape the Grand Prize card inside number 2. (That number is statistically the least likely to be rolled.)

Note: Make sure you CANNOT see through the envelopes. This is why I place the game cards in blank greeting cards with the game cards taped or glued inside.

## *Dice Game Instructions:*

1. Always play this game at the end of the party, after guests have had the chance to try or smell most of the products.
2. Put the prize basket of unopened, full-sized products on the table. This creates lots of excitement.
3. Explain that the basket on the table contains a bunch of prizes – both grand prizes and smaller product prizes of lesser value.
4. Say, “We are going to play a fun dice game, where you get the chance to win 1 of 3 incredible prizes.” Give the dice to the person who has

seemed most excited about the products so far. Say, *“Can you hold onto these while I explain the game, please?”*

5. Hold up the 11 envelopes. *“Inside these envelopes there are three different kinds of cards. The cards all have something for you to win in them. To play the game, you roll both dice, add the numbers together, and that's the envelope that you get to keep. Make sure to wait to open your envelope until everyone that wants to play has played. Inside the envelopes, a card will either say, Grand Prize, Win a Prize, or Win a Party. If you get an envelope with Grand Prize, I promise to let you pick a larger, full-sized product from this basket to take home. If you get Win a Prize, I promise to let you pick a smaller product from this basket to take home. If you get Win a Party on your card, remember that a hostess gets \$175 shopping spree for hosting a qualified party, so you get to win the opportunity to have your own ladies night and take advantage of our generous hostess shopping sprees.”*
6. Continue to say, *“There's only one big rule: If you the Grand Prize, I promise that you will get to pick a Grand Prize from this basket, to take home with you today. I also promise that if you get Win a Prize, you get to take home a smaller prize from my basket of prizes over there. If you get Win a Party, you have to promise me that you will book a party with me and get an amazing opportunity to relax and have fun with your friends, while earning an incredible hostess rewards.”*
7. Make sure to smile and be excited and enthusiastic. Say, *“Because of the Win a Party card in the game though, you can choose to PLAY or PASS, since there may be some of you that already know you can't or don't want to take the risk of winning a party. You can decide if you would like to play or pass; if you play, you must keep what is inside your envelope.”*
8. Have the person holding the dice start off the game by asking, *“Would you like to start us off?”*
